FOUR NEW UK DEGREE PROGRAMMES AT CINEC CAMPUS – METRO BRANCH

New degree programmes awarded by University of Wolverhampton and conducted at CINEC Campus – Metro Branch in Nugegoda were launched at an event held on 18th August 2023. This event held in the Auditorium of CINEC Campus Malabe was presided by Capt. Ajith Peiris, President and Executive Chairman of CINEC Campus. Prof. Chaminda Pathirage, Associate Head of School for Research and Professor at Brownfield Research and Innovation at School of Architecture and Built Environment, University of Wolverhampton, UK represented the University at this event.

It gives me great pleasure to be in CINEC to launch these new programmes". Prof. Pathirage, in his presentation, described

"These would in turn benefit CINEC students too as we aim to enhance knowledge transfer between University of Wolverhampton academics and CINEC academic community that includes staff as well as students", he added.
