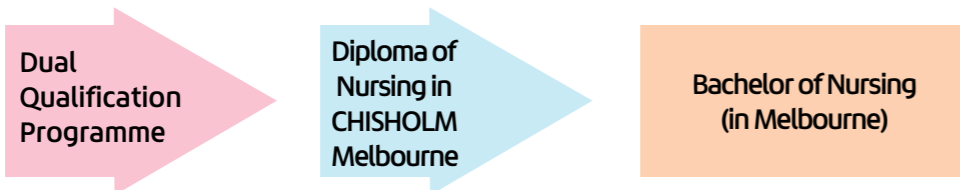
This Dual Qualification will prepare you for employment in aged and disability care industry as a direct support worker. It covers all aspects of support work for people living who are elderly, or, with intellectual and physical disabilities, within a residential care facility, a community services organisation or a medical facility that provides ageing and/or disability services. You may also be working with people in their own home and community providing one-on-one support.

With this course you will gain the skills and knowledge you need to support the personal care, wellbeing and daily activities of clients in need of specialised care.

You will learn how to be person centred, and support clients to develop individual support plans. We focus on your legal and ethical responsibilities; how to provide personalised support and the empowerment of people who are elderly and/or are living with a disability.

You'll also develop strategies for communicating with people who have complex communication needs and learn how to support the skill development of an elderly person, and a person with a disability. Throughout the course, you'll build up valuable skills that are necessary for working in the healthcare industry, from providing individual support to communicating with clients, colleagues, management and other industry providers.
